Undergraduate Curriculum and Policy Committee

Present: Lisa Baures (scribe), Rajiv Kapadia, Ron Nickerson (convener), Anne O'Meara, Guynel Reid, and Mavis Richardson (guest)

The committee reviewed and discussed curriculum proposals related to program redesign and the department name change submitted by Mass Communications. Mavis Richardson from the Mass Communications Department provided an explanation of the proposals and responded to questions. Her willingness to do so was greatly appreciated by the committee.

Lisa Baures moved to tentatively approve curriculum proposals 1958-1968, 1971-1972, 1975-1979, 1981-1983, 2006, 2023-2026, 2042, and 2056-2058. The motion was seconded by Anne O'Meara. Motion passed.

Anne O'Meara moved and Guynel Reid seconded the motion to grant final approval for curriculum proposal 2373. Motion passed.

Curriculum proposals 1970, 2000, 2059, and 2370 were sent back to the Mass Communications Departments for further clarification and revision.

Curriculum proposals from the College of Arts and Humanities that had been sent back for revision and subsequently resubmitted for approval were reviewed and discussed.

Motions to tentatively approve 1950, 1579, 2021-2022, and 2287 were put forward for consideration by Lisa Baures. Anne O'Meara seconded each of the motions. All motions passed.

Review and discussion of three university policies--Academic Re-evaluation, Awarding of Credit for the College Level Examination Program (CLEP), and Undergraduate Extended Learning Student Admission to the University were tabled, but will be placed on the next meeting agenda for UCAP.
